apparently and was forced back by a big sea. Simonds was thrown against the coping of the Jetty, and fell unconscious, only to pass away a few minutes

later.

The last time he was on the Tyne, one Sunday in July, he came all the way from Elswick, above Newcastle, to make his Communion and then gave up the rest of the morning to ship visiting, taking one of our boats and his own section of the river.

Absolutely "faithful unto death," so his passing to higher service in Southampton Water constitutes a new challenge to our work in that place.
