

R E P O R T  
ON CLOTHING, ETC., GIVEN SURVIVORS OF THE CREW OF  
R. M. S. TITANIC.

The men were first fitted out by the White Star Line on the Company's pier No. 61. At the same time Mrs. Bastedo supplemented what was being done by the Company. Afterwards the men crossed the street to the building of the American Seamen's Friend Society and were fitted out there. The details are as follows.

White Star Line: At the request and under the direction of Captain Smith, Marine Superintendent of the White Star Line, and at the expense of the Company, the Seamen's Christian Association, George A. Hearn, President and Stafford Wright, Executive; and the Seamen's Church Institute of New York, Bishop Greer, President and Edmund L. Baylies, Executive, furnished the following-named survivors, (see next page) of the crew of "Titanic" with articles of clothing as listed.

About 30 or 40 got overcoat and a number got extra suit of clothes. All officers were supplied with clothing from Brokaw Brothers at the expense of the White Star Line.

Mrs. W. A. Bastedo, assisted by Mrs. James E. Newcomb; They furnished, to all those who asked, safety razors and brushes, tooth brushes and tooth powder; also combs and brushes. All the stewardesses were given complete outfit. 500 collars, 300 neck ties, 600 handkerchiefs, 200 suspenders and about 75 overcoats were supplied. Their complete outfit was substantially the same as that of the White Star Line.

Women's Relief Committee: Through American Seamen's Friend Society, Rev. John B. Calvert, D.D., President and Rev. G. McPherson Hunter, Executive, furnished these members of crew, as marked, with outfit consisting of
