& Resolution.

"WHEREAS, The Master of Life in His wise Providence, has removed from among us by death our late associate and friend, James W. Underhill, a lay Vice President of this Board; one whose long and intimate relations with us, as an officer and member of the Board, and whose Christian co-operation in our work and personal friendship, endeared him to our hearts and commended him to our highest respect—

Resolved, That in his death we have to mourn the loss of an efficient co-worker, a valued friend, and a Christian brother, and one whose active usefulness in other enterprises of the Church, and many of the benevolent institutions of the city, makes his demise a memorable loss to us and to them.

Resolved, That we deeply sympathize with his sorrowing family, relatives and friends, and with the pastor and congregation with whom he was immediately connected in his public worship, and daily Christian work, in their loss, recognizing in our sorrow the infinite gain to him by his translation, through the merciful forgiveness of God, for the sake of Christ his Saviour, to the world of purity and peace.

Whereas, Since our last meeting Mr John

Resolved, that this Board cannot let this occasion pass - without making a record of, and bearing testimony to the example of deep piety, earnest zeal & self sacrificing labor of the departed - in promoting the temporal and spiritual welfare of Seamen - and by which we are encouraged and stimulated to renewed earnestness in the work of bringing the wandering Sailor to a knowledge of the Saviour.

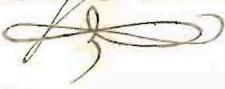
Resolved that this minute be transmitted to the widow of Mr John Ryne, with an expression of the sincere sympathy of the Members of this Board with her in her affliction
